The Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio met in regular session at the Miami Township Civic Building on September 14, 2020 with the following members present: Mary Makley Wolff, Ken Tracy and Karl Schultz.

A motion was made to adopt the following Resolution:

# RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio has in accordance with the provisions of law previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Clermont County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to this Board together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Board, and what part thereof is without and what part within, the ten mill tax limitation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio by authority of Sections 5705.34 and 5705.35 of the Ohio Revised Code, as follows:

- **SECTION 1**: That the amounts and rates, as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, be and the same are hereby accepted.
- **SECTION 2**: That there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said Township the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation as specified in attachments listed as Schedule A and Schedule B.
- **SECTION 3**: That the Fiscal Officer of Miami Township be, and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Auditor of said County.
- **SECTION 4**: The Board does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to Section 504.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, and authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

**SECTION 5**: That this Board of Trustees hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 6**: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
